Booking Terms and Conditions

1 All bookings are made with Adventure Mania,(Registered Company), whose registered office is 13/3 , Sarat Chandra Atta Lane, Belur Math, Howrah - 711 202 West Bengal , INDIA. Landline +91 33 26542824 /+91 33 5535 1916

2 As a member of the Travel Agents Association of Bengal (TAAB), an Association approved by the Department of Trade and Industry, The Company has provided a Bond to meet the requirements of the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992. This bond provides security for money paid by you in respect of the expedition cost.

3 A-6000 m Peak Climbing -£200 or equivalent in US\$ advance amount for 6000m peaks and treks.

B-7000 m Peak Climbing -£300 or equivalent in US\$ advance amount payable at Adventure Mania U.K.

C-Himalayan Treks and Other Trips: -£200 or equivalent in US\$ advance amount payable at Adventure Mania U.K.

4 The final balance should reach The Company no later than 60 days before the expedition. If the balance is not received by the specified date, we reserve the right to cancel your booking and your deposit will be forfeited, unless a delay in your payment has been agreed by a director of The Company. Bookings accepted after the balance due date can be secured with the appropriate deposit and full payment must then reach us within 7 days of us confirming your booking.

5 Notice of cancellation must be given in writing. Should you cancel, the following scale of charges will apply:

Cancellation more than 60 days before departure - loss of deposit.

Cancellation 29 days to 59 before departure - 30% of total trip cost.

Cancellation 10 to 28 days before departure - 60% of total trip cost.

Cancellation less than 10 days before departure - 100% of total trip cost.

Such terms are adopted throughout the travel industry and cover the costs of advance payments made by The Company. Cancellation charges may be covered by your travel insurance provided the reason for cancellation falls within the terms of the policy.

6 If you wish to transfer from one expedition to another, an administration charge of £50 will be payable, up to the time that the final balance becomes due. Any transfer after this point will be treated as a cancellation. A transfer request must be notified in writing and will not be actioned on the original trip booked until the administration charge has

been received. Transfers are not possible from expeditions which require a larger deposit than £300.

7 Whilst every effort will be made to adhere to the planned itinerary, it must be realized that with this type of adventurous activity changes to the programme will occur from time to time. The Company accepts neither responsibility nor liability, for any ensuing costs, or the consequences of any such change, however caused.

8 Circumstances may arise where we are forced to alter dates, expedition duration, flight schedules, trekking routes, or hotel accommodation before an expedition starts. We will try to inform you of any such changes as soon as we know of them.

9 On assessing the conditions expected to be encountered in the mountains or the abilities of the Team Members, our Expedition Leaders may decide to alter any proposed route (whether to be undertaken by vehicle or on foot), mountain objective, mountain route or activity if they believe that to continue with the published itinerary, or any latterly agreed alternative, would place anyone at undue risk.

10 Our Expedition Leaders will do their utmost to ensure that any problems are solved for the benefit of the Team as a whole. Signing the booking form signifies your acceptance of the Expedition Leader's authority to make decisions affecting the group or individuals. For instance, the Expedition Leader may require an individual or individuals to leave the expedition if they believe that a person or persons health is at risk, if an illegal act is committed, or behavior may become, or has been, detrimental to the safety, enjoyment or well-being of the group.

11 A client leaving an expedition at any stage, for whatever reason, will not be entitled to any refund unless agreed by a Director of The Company.

12 Team sizes described in this brochure are target sizes and may be changed at the discretion of The Company. Similarly, leaders named in expedition descriptions may also be changed.

13 We reserve the right to cancel any expedition which does not receive sufficient bookings to make it financially viable.

14 Anyone booked onto an expedition cancelled by The Company will be entitled to a full refund. Anyone on such an expedition will be invited to transfer to another expedition and no transfer fee will be payable. Should they transfer to another expedition any difference in price will be invoiced or credited accordingly.

15 Climbing and Mountaineering are hazardous activities with a risk of serious injury or death. By signing these booking conditions you acknowledge these hazards and your acceptance of the associated risks.

16 Neither The Company nor any of its representatives will be responsible for any illness, injury or death sustained on our Mountaineering expeditions, nor will they be liable for any uninsured loss of personal property.

17 The Company cannot be made liable for the consequences of strikes, industrial action, wars, riots, sickness, quarantine, government intervention, weather conditions, or other untoward occurrences, whatever they may be.

18 In the event of civil unrest in a particular region, we undertake to inform our clients of the situation as soon as we have knowledge of it.

19 For all expeditions, you are advised to have insurance that covers you for all of the activities to be undertaken, including adequate insurance for mountaineering including cover for search, helicopter rescue and medical repatriation.

20 Having made every effort to ensure the correctness of this website, we cannot be held responsible for any inaccuracies.

21 Prices on this website are based on costs and exchange rates as at 01.11.2003. We sincerely hope that surcharges will not be necessary, but in the unlikely event that they are, you may cancel your booking without penalty if the surcharge amounts to more than 10% of the cost of the Expedition.

22 The Company's agents and representatives, other than a Director of The Company, are not entitled to promise re funds for whatever reason, and The Company will not be bound by any such promises.
